While having the mantle of helping the Body Of Christ in these last days; while being responsible for accurate teaching and study regarding the faith; while occupying high positions in the public eye as leaders; and while having been exposed to the truths of the Bible for years and years—

—they say things like: “There is no mention of hell in the Hebrew Bible;” “There is no actual verification of the Divinity of Jesus Christ;” “We cannot with accuracy subscribe to the doctrine of the Virgin Birth;” “There is mounting evidence against the Resurrection;” “The Ten Plagues Of Egypt can be explained through natural scientific process, seasonal conditions, and natural processes...”

How can you knowingly betray your faith by being a party to programs with names like “The Ten Plagues Of Egypt—” which sound like a scientific verification of an event from the Bible—which then proceeds to explain away the miraculous events promulgated by God into natural causes?
